CHASE & WILD CAT DIY BIKE HELMETS CRAFT

SUPPLIES

- Bike Helmets (One Blue and One White) • Brown, Pink, White, Red, and Yellow Foam Sheets • Template for Ears and Stripes
- Yellow Star Sticker • Round Double-Sided Adhesive Fasteners • Glue Dots or Glue Gun • Scissors • Pencil

INSTRUCTIONS

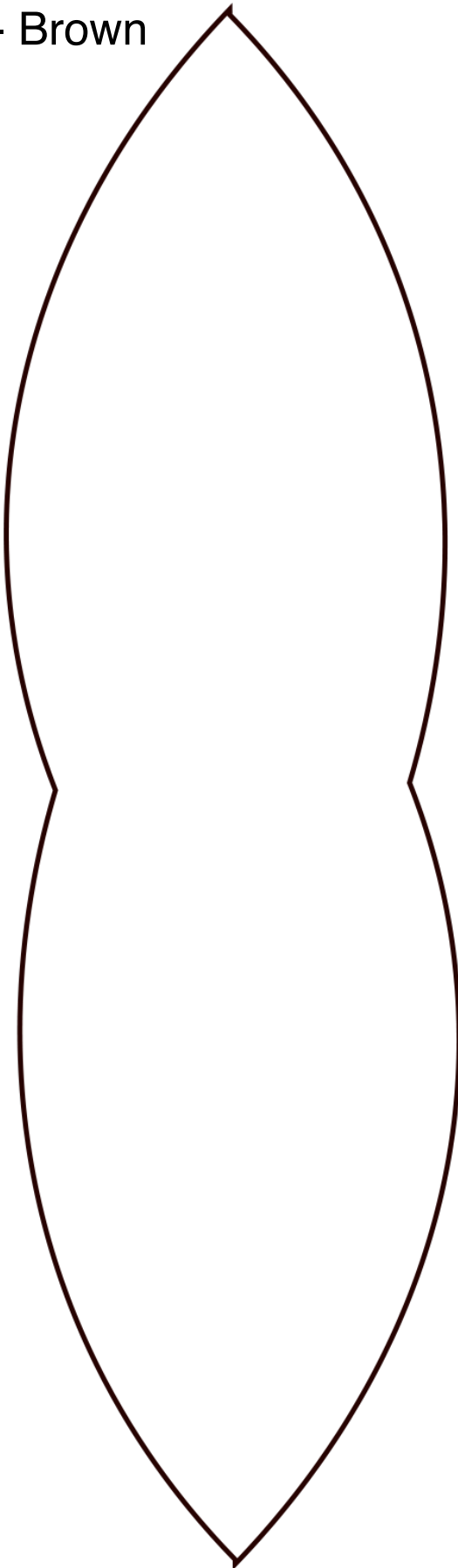
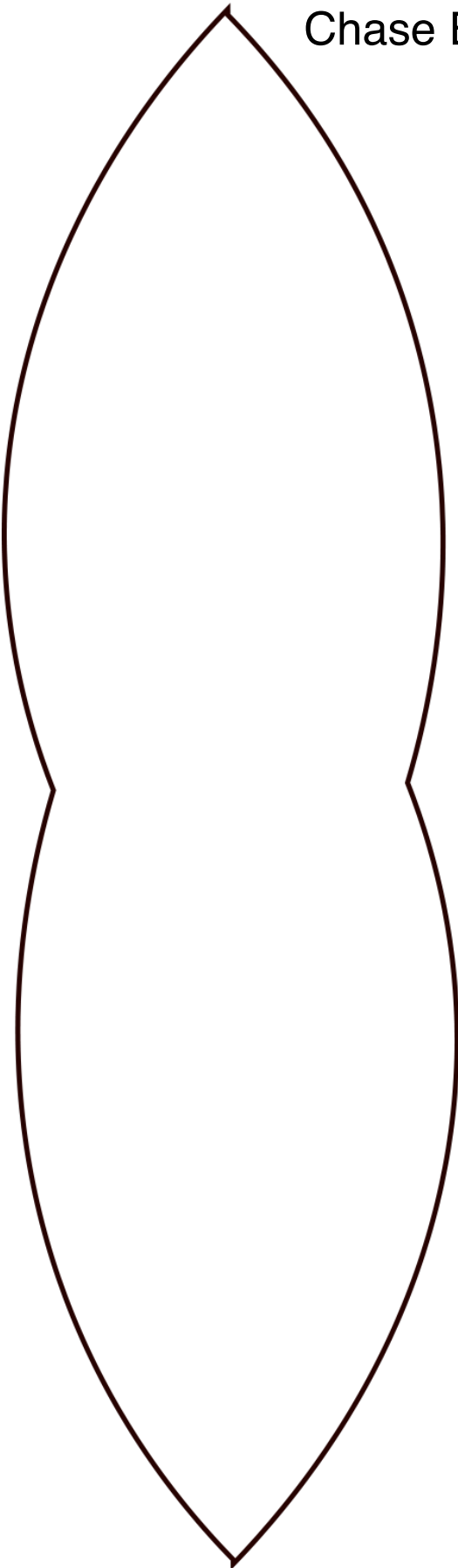
1. Print out all the cutting templates. Cut out the templates to use as guides on the foam.
2. Trace and then cut out each piece on the corresponding foam.
3. Once you have everything cut out, grab your brown and white ear pieces. Using Glue Dots or a glue gun, apply a generous amount to one side of the foam leaving space at the bottom for attaching the ears to the helmet. Fold the other side and press down. Repeat this for each ear.
4. For Chase, apply glue generously to the pink foam pieces and press onto the brown ears.
5. For Wild Cat, apply glue and arrange the stripes on the side of the ear, with some hanging off the edge. This makes it easier to press onto the white ears. Cut off anything that is hanging over.
6. Using your yellow star sticker, trace a circle in the yellow foam that will be large enough to encircle the sticker. Cut out your circles and stick a star sticker in the center of each.
7. Now it's time to attach your ears. Using your double-sided adhesive fasteners, attach two on each end of the ears. Stick the fasteners together, sticky side out and then place at a slight sideways angle on the helmet. Press down firmly. Repeat this step for each ear.
8. Finally, attach the star sticker (their badges) onto the helmet using the same double-sided adhesive fasteners. And with that your little one is ready for a PAWsome ride!

*Allow fasteners to stick in place for at least 30 minutes before heading outside. If anything seems loose (bike helmets can vary in texture and smoothness), add additional glue dots, hot glue, or crazy glue to ensure everything stays put.
